## Trigger

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I'm Special!



### Material

- Document "God made me special" (attached God made me special)
- Ink

### Steps

1. First, ask the children to fill out the sheet "God made me special". Let them put their fingerprints in the right place.
2. Then have a discussion with them about the fact that God created them all unique and special. Some children may share what they have written on their sheet.

## Object Lesson

### Created In His Image

#### Material

- Photo of a famous person or photo of a child in the group

#### Steps

1. Tell the children that a photo is “a physical resemblance or representation of a person, animal or thing, photographed, painted, or sculpted.”
2. Then take a picture of someone who is in the group with a digital camera or bring a picture of someone that everyone will recognize as a famous person.
3. Ask them if the photo is actually that person. Of course not. The photo cannot speak or think, but it shows a lot about the person and what they are like. Similarly, we are created in the ‘image of God’. We are not God, but created to be like him and reflect what he is. God created us in his image to be perfect, but just as a computer can “distort” or change a photo until you can no longer recognize the person in the picture, sin has distorted the image of God in us. God, however, sent his perfect image, Jesus Christ, to restore the image of God in us as we accept him as our Savior and our Lord.
4. Read the following verse.
  - “So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image..” 2 Corinthians 3:18

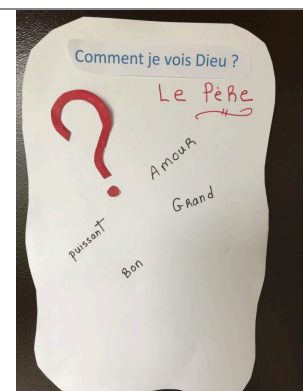

## The Heart Of The Father

### & Prayer

Adam was the first man, the first husband, the first father, but also the first son. He was created like God. Genesis 1:27 tells us so well: “So God created human beings in his own image”.

You too were created in the image of God, Adam had God as a father just like you have God the Father as Dad. Psalm 139.16 reminds us of “You saw me before I was born.” When you were little in your mother’s womb, God the Father



had his loving eyes on you. God desires to be a Father to you, just as he was to Adam. Receive his love.

## Craft

### Creative As Your Creator

#### Material

- Plastic cups
- Jars
- Wooden blocks
- Popsicle sticks
- Toothpicks
- Marshmallows
- Jujubes
- Spaghetti



#### Steps

1. Place all the material on the tables.
2. Ask the children to create structures using the material.
3. Let them be creative.

## Activity

### Find The Differences

#### Material

- Find the differences game (attachment adam differences)
- Coloured pencils

#### Steps

1. Print the game in sufficient quantities.
2. Give it to the children.
3. Ask them to compare the 2 images and circle all the differences in the 2nd image.



4. Ask them to colour the drawings.

## Physical Activity

### Adam And The Animals

#### Materiall

- None

#### Steps

1. Ask the children to choose an animal.
2. Ask them to form a circle.
3. Ask a child to be Adam and place him in the centre.
4. Then give the name of an animal that has been chosen.
5. Adam must then go and touch the person who has chosen that animal before that person says the name of another animal.
6. If Adam succeeds, he swaps his place with that person. Otherwise, the game continues until he (Adam) succeeds.
7. When Adam joins the circle, he does not take the name of the losing person, he must have his own animal name.



## Snack

### Create Your Character As God Created You

#### Material

- Cardboard plates
- Markers
- Cheerios to make hair
- Strawberry slices (for cheeks)
- Broccoli (for eyebrows)



#### Steps

1. Place all the ingredients on the table.
2. Give a plate to each child.
3. Ask them to draw with the markers the face of a character in the centre of the plate.
4. Then ask the children to finish the creation of their character with the items on the table.
5. Encourage them to be creative.
