

# Adam

## Trigger

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### Self Discovery

#### Material

- Large sheet of paper
- Children's silhouettes (1 per child)
- Coloured pencils



#### Steps

1. Place a large sheet of paper on the floor.
2. Ask a child to lie on the sheet.
3. Draw the outline of his body.
4. Then bring the silhouette to a table.
5. Draw face, hair, clothing, etc.
6. Give the children coloured pencils and tell them to colour the silhouette.
7. If you have a large group, make several silhouettes.
8. While the children are colouring, sing a song about creation.

#### Optional

- Give each child a copy of the child's silhouette.
- Ask each child to colour the silhouette to make it look like it.

## Object Lesson

### God Did

#### Material

- A girl doll
- A boy doll



#### Steps

1. Show the dolls that represent Adam and Eve.
2. Recite and mime the verse. Encourage the children to do the gestures with you.

### Nursery Rhyme

- God made the mountains and trees very high  
(Stand on tiptoe and spread your arms upwards, then lower them into a semicircle on each side of the body.)
- God made flowers and all the little birds  
(Crouch down and place your right hand close to the ground as if to show something small.)
- God made the animals you see  
(Place your hands folded at your wrists as if to imitate a rabbit.)
- And God made people like you and me  
(Point up, point to the children, then to you.)

## The Heart of the Father

### & Prayer

Adam was the first man, the first husband, the first father, but also the first son. He was created by God, “created in the image of God”, (Genesis 1:27) and he looked like him.

You too were created in the image of God. Adam had God as a father just like you have God the Father as Dad. Psalm 139:16 states, “You saw me before I was born.” When you were little in your mother’s womb, God the father already



had his loving eyes on you. God desires to be a father to you, just as he has been to Adam. Receive his love.

## Prayer

"I thank you Father for imagining my birth, thank you for the life you gave me. Help me get to know you better every day and make you my Father. I love you. Amen."

## Application: The Father Loves Me

1. Show the kids a mirror.
2. Tell the children to look in the mirror and say this: "I am the daughter/son of God the Father, God is my daddy and he loves me."

## Craft

### Funny Bag

#### Material

- Paper bags
- Coloured paper
- Clothespins
- Glue
- Paint
- Stickers
- Scissors
- Markers
- Adhesive tape



#### Steps

1. Ask the children to fold the top of the paper bag about 10 cm.
2. Ask them to bend the bottom 2 corners inwards to form a sharp snout.
3. Then ask them to attach the flaps of the snout with tape (at the back of the snout).
4. They can now paint the bird's body and eyes.
5. Then ask them to cut the bird's beak into coloured paper and stick it on the bag.
6. Ask them to use stickers and markers to finish the head.
7. Ask them to fill the bag with surprises for their friends.
8. Ask them to close the bag with a clothespin.

## Activity

### Find The Differences

#### Material

- Differences game ([attachment adam differences](#))
- Coloured pencils

#### Steps

1. Print the game in sufficient quantities.
2. Give it to the children.
3. Ask them to compare the 2 pictures and circle all the differences in the second picture.
4. Ask them to colour the drawings.



## Physical Activity

### Name The Animal

#### Material

- Animal illustrations on paper ([download](#))

#### Steps

1. Have the children sit in a circle.
2. Place the visual aids in the center of the circle.
3. Give each child an animal illustration.
4. Tell the children to pretend to help Adam name the animals.
5. Show one of the animal illustrations.
6. Ask the children to say incorrect names for the animal. They may suggest “elephant” or “zebra” when it comes to a rabbit, for example.
7. The child with the illustration in his hand should shake his head to say no until the real name of the animal is suggested.



#### Discussion

- God asked Adam to name all the animals.
- Do you think Adam was happy to find a name for all the animals?
- What is the next animal we are going to name?

## Snack

### Create Your Character As God Created You

#### Material

- Cardboard plates
- Markers
- Cheerios to make hair
- Strawberry slices (for cheeks)
- Broccoli (for eyebrows)



#### Steps

1. Place all ingredients on the table.
2. Give a plate to each child.
3. Ask them to draw the face of a character in the center of the plate with the markers.
4. Then ask the children to finalize the creation of their character with the ingredients on the table.
5. Encourage them to be creative.
