



## Object Lesson

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### God Loves All The Children Of The World

#### Material

- Illustrations of children (girls and boys)



#### Steps

1. Before class, cut out pictures of children from magazines, girls and boys from various backgrounds or from social situations mentioned in the nursery rhyme.
2. Tape the pictures to a heart-shaped cardboard box at the top of which you write "God loves all the children of the world."
3. Draw children's attention to the pictures.
4. Say: "God has placed children on earth very different from one another. God loves all these different children he has placed on earth."
5. Teach the nursery rhyme by showing the pictures of the children in question.

#### Nursery Rhyme

God loves all the children of the world  
Every minute, every second  
His great love for them abounds  
God loves the children of the bush (African)  
And those from the country next door (depending on your region)  
Those who feed on couscous (Arabic)  
And those who drink only tea (Indian)  
God loves almond-shaped eyes (Inuit)  
And tight curly hair (Israeli).  
He loves your friends (group of good children)  
And the tough guys of the neighborhood (group of rebellious children)  
God loves all the children of the world  
Every minute, every second  
His great love for them abounds

## The Heart Of The Father

### & Prayer

### Application

## Craft

### Palm Tree

#### Material

- Scissors
- Green and brown construction paper
- Glue stick
- Pencils



#### Steps

1. Make a model for the kids.
2. Ask the children to draw a tree trunk on the brown cardboard and to cut it out.
3. Have them trace a hand on the green construction paper and cut it out.
4. Encourage the children to repeat step 2 and 3 as many times as they like.
5. Finally, ask them to glue the handprints on the top of the trunk to make a palm tree.

## Activity

### Find The Exact Shadow

#### Material

- Shadow Template (attachment)
- Pencils



#### Steps

1. Give each child a copy.
2. This is the principle of the association game.
3. Ask the children to find the shadow that matches the image.

## Physical Activity

### Follow The Guide

#### Material (for the game)

- Paper
- Scissors



#### Steps (for the game)

1. Cut the paper into a foot shape.
2. Place the feet to create a path and place them so they go in different directions.
3. On your signal, ask the children to follow the direction of the feet and to follow the path.
4. Explain how Deborah received instructions from God and how she had to follow them just as they follow the direction of the feet.

## Snack

### Palm Trees

#### Material

- Blueberries
- Large pretzels or wafers
- Apples
- Plates

#### Steps

1. Slice apples.
2. Give each child a plate, a large pretzel, three blueberries and four pieces of apples.
3. Place the pretzel flat on the plate.
4. Place the apples on top of the pretzel, the corners facing the top of the pretzel.
5. Place the blueberries on the apples at the end of the pretzel.
