He Is Our Peace

Material

Images of situations of peace and stress (attachement voir siteweb)





Steps

- 1. Read Hebrews 7:1-11 with the children.
- 2. Tell the children that Melchizedek means king of justice, king of peace (Hebrews 7:2).
- 3. Show images of all kinds of situations. Ask the children what they think are the situations of peace and situations where there is no peace (attachment images).
- 4. Tell the children that peace does not mean that we no longer have difficulties, conflicts or problems. If you know the King of Peace, Jesus, even in difficulties, in stressful situations, you can have peace and remain calm and quiet.

Object Lesson

Tithing

Material

1 bag of 10 sweets for each child

Steps

- 1. Explain to the children that Abraham presented Melchizedek with tithing (one-tenth) of all that he had. By this act, Abraham indicated that he recognized Melchizedek as both a co-worshipper of the one true God, as well as a highly qualified priest superior to him in spiritual rank and maturity. Read this verse to the children: "Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce.!" Proverbs 3:9 NLT
- 2. Then give the children a bag of 10 sweets.
- 3. Ask them for the tithe of that bag of candy.
- 4. Explain that it is a principle of gratitude to God, everything we have comes from Him, and we agree to give him 1 tenth of what we have.

& Prayer

Discussion

How do you think the Father blesses you?

Give children the opportunity to reflect on the Father's blessings.

He blesses us with the breath of life every day, beautiful nature, our families, school that allows us to learn many things, food, our homes, our toys, etc.

These times of discussion are a good way to have a heart to heart with children and are important to create a good relationship with the children in our classes.

Craft

The Symbol Of Peace

Material

- White paper
- Painting (water based) of all colours
- Pencils
- **Plates**

Steps

- 1. Give each child a blank sheet.
- 2. Put paint on the plates and place them on the craft table.
- 3. Ask the children to draw a peace symbol with a pencil.
- 4. Then ask them to decorate this peace symbol with paint.

Optional

You can also do this craft together with several children, each of them being assigned to a specific colour. For example, in a team of 4, child 1 will put the red paint on all symbols, child 2, blue paint, child 3 green ones and child 4 yellows. Finally, the 4 children worked on the 4 crafts.

Activity

Messy Words

Material

- Activity sheet (attachement on the website)
- Pencils

Steps

- 1. Give each child an activity sheet and a pencil.
- 2. Ask the children to put the letters of Melchizedek's words in the right order.

Answers

King, Salem, priest, blessing, bread, justice, peace, Abraham, Jesus, tenth





Physical Activity

Tag You're It "Blessings-Dime"

Material

- Coupons
- False coins



Steps

- 1. Before class, write 10, 20 or 30 on several coupons.
- 2. Choose a child who will be the tag. He must try to catch the other players. When a child is tagged, they must sit on the floor and receive a coupon (a facilitator comes to give them one) with a number written (10, 20 or 30).
- 3. When the game ends, each child claims his blessing (of 10, 20, or 30 false coins) and must give the tithe of their blessing to the one who was the tag.

Snack

Bread And Wine

Material

- Grape juice
- Dinner Rolls (or small breads)
- Plates
- Pastic cup



Steps

- 1. Give each child 1 cup filled with grape juice and 1 plate with a roll.
- 2. While the children eat their snacks, remind them that Melchizedek brought bread and wine to Abraham.
