## **Trigger**

### Don't Touch

#### **Material**

- Glass
- Grape juice
- Image of a dead animal
- Hair
- Scissors

### **Steps**

- 1. In front of the children, fill the glass with grape juice.
- 2. Show them the image of the dead animal.
- 3. Show hair and scissors.
- 4. Explain how Samson was not allowed to touch any of these items.

## **Optional**

If you want, you can tell the children not to touch any of the items during the whole lesson.

## **Object Lesson**

## I Need To Grow Up

#### **Material**

· Ribbon to tie hair

### **Steps**

- 1. Ask a young girl if she agrees to be have seven braids.
- 2. Make her seven braids as you recite the nursery rhyme.
- 3. Recite and mime the rhyme. Encourage the children to do the gestures with you.

### **Nursery Rhyme**

- Head, shoulders, knees, toes
   (Touch each of the parts mentioned.)
- God knows me from head to toe
   (Point to the sky and then touch your head and then your feet.)
- He knows everything I need
   (Point to the sky at "he"
   then your head to "knows,"
   spread your arms to "everything"
   point at you at "I" and arms in front of you, elbows bent and palms facing the sky, fold your fingers on the palms to "need".)
- I need to grow up (Scream this last line.)

## The Heart of the Father

### & Prayer

Samson received a great mission from God, but his mission came with things to do that he had to respect: not to cut his hair and not to drink alcohol. In exchange for his obedience to God, he received incredible strength. A great strength. It must have been difficult at times for Samson to meet that request. But he was faithful and he respected God's request.



The Father has a great mission for you too, he has a mission for each of us. It's up to us to find out. What he asks you to do is obey him. ## Craft

## Samson The Powerful Judge

#### **Material**

- 15 cm drawing of a face
- Paper (for arms)
- Coloured Pencils
- Craft sticks (popsicle sticks)
- Glue
- Wool

### **Steps**

- 1. Draw and cut a face 15 cm in diameter for each child.
- 2. Draw muscular arms and cut them out for each child.
- 3. Give these to each child and tell them to colour the muscular face and arms.
- 4. Ask the children to glue these on a craft stick.
- 5. Make 7 braids with wool for each child. (Prepare them before class starts.)
- 6. Ask the children to glue the seven braids on Samson's head.
- 7. Children can hold their "marionette" and speak with their loudest voice.





#### Samson Made Of Cardboard

#### **Material**

- Scissors
- White paper sheet
- Coloured pencils and markers
- Ribbon
- Adhesive tape
- Toilet paper rolls

### **Steps**

- Print the model.
- Ask the children to colour Samson with coloured pencils.
- Then to start cutting it out.
- Ask the children to colour the toilet paper roll to create Samson's body.
- Ask the children to glue the heads and arms on the sides with tape.
- Make the connection with the story of the day.

## **Activity**

#### The Seven Braids

#### **Material**

- Pipe cleaner
- Styrofoam ball
- · Coloured pearls

### **Steps**

- 1. Give 7 pipe cleaners to each child.
- 2. Ask the children to put beads on the pipe cleaners to create 7 braids.
- 3. Make the connection with the story: in the Bible, Samson had 7 braids.





## **Physical Activity**

## Keeping The Philistines Away

#### **Material**

- Balloons
- Empty paper towel rolls (1 per child)

## **Steps**

- 1. Ask the children to stand on one side of the room and give them all an empty paper towel roll.
- 2. Place the balloons in front of them.
- 3. Tell the children that at your signal, they must bring the balloons to the other side of the room using their roller.
- 4. Make the connection with the story in the Bible. Samson kept the Philistines away from the Israelites.

## **Snack**

### Samson's Weights

#### **Material**

- 1 package of fudge stripes cookies
- Six oz. chocolate to melt
- 5 long pretzels
- 10 LifeSavers candies
- Tube of white icing

#### **Steps**

- 1. Prepare the snack before class.
- 2. Melt chocolate according to the instructions on the packaging.
- 3. Break the ends of the pretzel stems, so that each stem is approximately 5-6" long.
- 4. Spoon the melted chocolate over the center of each pretzel stick, leaving about 3/4" of the ends uncoated.
- 5. Slide 3 cookies on each end of the pretzel stems, dry them on wax paper. Melted chocolate will help the cookies stay in place (so do it when the chocolate is still liquid).
- 6. Slide LifeSavers candy on the ends of each pretzel stick.
- 7. Now, if you want to add numbers to your weights, (it adds a little something): use tube of white icing.
