# **Trigger**

#### Share

#### Material

- Plate
- Ball
- Bins

## Steps

- 1. Make a hole in a plate large enough for a single ball to fall into.
- 2. Place bins all around the room.
- 3. Give a child a plate with the hole and put some balls in it.
- 4. The child must drop a ball into each of the bins around the room without letting the balls fall outside. Just like Lydia, the child must share what he has with the bins.

# Steps

- 1. One by one, show each of the items you brought in the paper or fabric bag.
- 2. Discuss it using the following questions: How many people can benefit from this (article name) if I use it alone? How many people can enjoy it if I share it? How could I share it?
- 3. After discussing all the objects with the children, ask them: What do you have that you could share with someone else? How could you share it?

# Cross in purple

#### Material

- Paper
- Scissors





- Different purple fabrics
- Glue

## Steps

- 1. With the children, cut out the shape of a cross from the sheet of paper.
- 2. Then, cut small squares in the different purple fabrics.
- 3. Finally, tell the children to glue the small pieces of fabric to cover the cross.
- 4. Make the connection with the story of the day.

# Steps

- 1. Distribute 1 "tie dye" box to each child.
- 2. Carry out the steps of the "tie dye" on the boxes with the children. The steps will certainly vary from one box to another.
- 3. Make the connection with the story of the day.


# **Physical Activity**

#### Shoot to score

#### Material

- Paper with holes and targets
- Paper





## Steps

- 1. Before class, take a large piece of paper and create large holes of different sizes, but always make sure a paper airplane can fit through.
- 2. Record the score next to each hole on the paper. The more difficult the hole, the higher the score should be.
- 3. When the kids arrive, help them make paper airplanes.





- 4. Have them fly their plane through the holes in the paper.
- 5. Explain to the children that Lydia was an entrepreneur and that she had to make good sales. She had to somehow get good "targets", a good "score".

#### Snack

#### Lydia's clothes

#### Material

- Bread
- Vegetables
- Fruits
- Knife
- Plates



- 1. Cut the bread into a human shape.
- 2. Cut vegetables and fruits into different clothes shapes. For example, cucumbers in pants, peppers in dresses, carrots in shorts, apples in skirts, pears in shirts, grapes in shoes.
- 3. Distribute the pieces of bread and fruits and vegetables to all the children on plates.
- 4. Ask them to dress the bread dummy in different clothes.
