## Trigger

When I go on a trip, I put in my...

### Material

- Suitcase
- Items for travel



### Steps

1. Spread out the items for the trip with Paul on a table or on the floor.
2. Take a suitcase and put things inside as the child mentions it.
3. Each time we close the suitcase and ask: “What did I take in my suitcase?”
4. All together the players must find all the objects in the suitcase that are taken out during the enumeration, to check.

## Object Lesson

Leave a mark

### Material

- 1 cup wet, used coffee grounds
- ½ cup of cold coffee
- 1 cup flour
- ½ cup salt
- Waxed paper
- Bowl
- Wooden spoon
- Rolling pin

### Steps

1. Before class, prepare the activity.
2. Take out a large bowl. Put in the wet coffee grounds, cold coffee, flour and salt.
3. Mix them with the spoon. You can use your hands to make sure the mixture is smooth and completely moist. The result will look like muddy clay.
4. Unroll a sheet of waxed paper.
5. Put a handful of the mixture on the waxed paper and use your hand or the rolling pin to form a ball ½ inch thick.
6. Tell each child to stick your fingers in the ball and make a handprint.
7. Once each child has made their masterpiece, let the result dry at room temperature for a few days.
8. Repeat with each child.
9. Let the children take their work home to see it dry.
10. Make the connection with the story of the day. Timothy's teachings are still relevant and are taught to stay.

## Craft

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### Bible bookmark

#### Material

- Craft materials: paper, cardboard, popsicle sticks, pencils, glue, ribbons, etc.



#### Steps

1. Place the materials on the tables.
2. Tell the children to create a bookmark for their Bible.
3. Let the children be creative.
4. Remind the children that Timothy knew his Bible well.

## Activity

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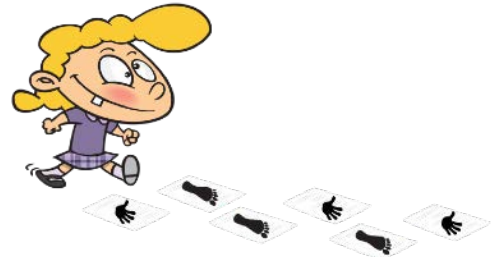
### Follow the steps

#### Material

- Hand and foot prints (attachment)

#### Steps

1. Print the images of the hand and foot prints.
2. Stick three footprints of your choice on the ground, side by side.
3. Stick three different prints in front of the first three.
4. Continue in this way until a path is created.
5. At your signal, the children must walk the path following the footprints. They must place their foot on a footprint and their hand on a handprint.
6. Each child must go through this path following the steps indicated on the floor just as Timothy followed in the footsteps of Paul.



## Physical Activity

Be the guide

### Material

- Pipes cut in half
- Balls
- Bucket



### Steps

1. Place a bucket at one end of the room.
2. Place the children in a row at the other end of the room.
3. Give each child a pipe cut in half and a ball.
4. On your cue, have the kids go carry a ball into the bucket across the room using only their pipe.
5. Explain that Timothy had to help the church understand the preaching of the Apostle Paul.

## Snack

Backpacking across the country

### Material

- Deli
- Cheese
- Pretzel sticks
- Plates



### Steps

1. Distribute one plate per child.
2. Tell the kids to roll a deli.
3. Then tell them to wrap the cheese around the charcuterie.
4. Have the children pierce the entire roll with the pretzel stick.
5. This creates a travel bag for Timothy when traveling with Paul.
