Choosing To Bless

Material

- Surprises

Steps

1. Place the surprises on a table so that all the children can see them.
2. Ask a child to come and choose two.
3. Then ask the child if he wants to give one of his surprises to a friend.
4. Repeat the steps until you have no more surprises.
5. Explain to the children that in the Bible there was a man who had the choice, like them, to bless and that he decided to do so.

Object Lesson

God Will Help Me Do Good

Material

- Toys

Steps

1. Place toys on the floor.
2. Tell the nursery rhyme with mime asking the children to listen and watch.
3. Repeat it slowly, encouraging the children to do the gestures with you.



Nursery Rhyme

- God will help me do good
(Point to the sky, then point to yourself.)
- In the evening as well as in the morning
(Tilt your head over your clasped hands, stretch out.)
- Whether I'm working or running
(Pick up toys, then pretend to run.)
- God will help me every day
(Point to the sky, then point to yourself.)

The Heart of the Father

& Prayer

Melchizedek, the man with a big heart. He is an example of generosity for us. He was a generous man who loved to bless others.

Prayer

Discussion

How do you think the Father blesses you?

Give children the opportunity to reflect on the Father’s blessings.

He blesses us with the breath of life every day, beautiful nature, our families, school that allows us to learn many things, food, our houses, our toys, etc.

These times of discussion are a good way to have a heart to heart with children and they are important to create a good relationship with the children in our classes.

Craft

Silver Jars

Material

- Mason jars
- Adhesive tape with patterns
- Labels that read “Tithe” (either bought or made with paper)



Steps

1. Give each child a jar.
2. Let each child decorate their jar with the different tapes.
3. Stick a label on the jar.

Activity

Trace The Money

Material

- White paper
- Coins
- Coloured pencils

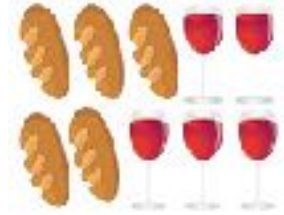


Steps

1. Give a sheet of paper to each child and ask them to draw a large circle in the middle.
2. Distribute the coins and tell the children to place them under the paper in the area of the large circle.
3. Then ask them to colour the paper where the coins are positioned to make them visible on the paper.

Physical Activity

Bring More Bread And Wine



Material

- Pictures of bread (attachment)
- Pictures of wine (attachment)

Steps

1. Hide pictures of bread and wine in the classroom without the children knowing.
2. On your cue, ask the children to find all the pictures of bread and wine hidden in the classroom.
3. Explain how, in the Bible, Melchizedek gave bread and wine to help Abraham.

Snack

Cheese And Carrot Currency



Material

- 1 large carrot, washed
- Small block of cheese
- Vegetable peeler
- Small sharp knife
- Mini bento cutter/ mini cookie cutter

Steps

1. Prepare the snack before class.
2. Peel the carrot, then cut it into thick slices or slices.
3. Cut slices of cheddar cheese the same thickness as carrot slices.
4. Cut a shape in each carrot slice with a mini cookie cutter.
5. Cut the same shape in each slice of cheese using the same cookie cutter.
6. Slide the shape of the cheese into each carrot slice.
7. Repeat until you have as many “coins” as necessary.
8. Distribute the snack to the children and make the connection with the story of the day.

Optional

- Create different coins using various cookie cutters.
- Use rainbow carrots.
- You can cook the carrots before using them.
- You can also apply this technique to other vegetables, such as carrots in cucumber slices.
